2013 was a difficult year for the Association in that the crucial portfolios of Match and Tournament Directors were unfilled most of the year. This placed an additional burden on David Cooper and Bob Lake both of whom were laid low with ill health during the year. Bob Lake is to be commended for staying in the job until the end of May when Irwin Parker reluctantly took over the job. He had not planned to do so as he had prearranged an extensive amount of travel. An attempt to fill the position only met with limited success as the appointee left before the probation period expired. However as a positive he did make a start on the work of setting up an e-mail communication system. More recently the Association has appointed Linda Bell with a view to her taking over the Executive Directors position after the AGM.

In the absence of a Tournament Director, Irwin Parker took on the overall responsibility for running the West Coast and State Championships. It would not have been possible to cope with this without the assistance of Helen Valentine, Verona Johnstone, Lyn Nolan and Dave Cooper who dragged himself out of a sick bed to collate state entries and do the draw. Additionally the task of running the Grand Prixs was spread between Dave, Bob and Irwin. It is important that this important board position is covered in 2014 as volunteers may not be so easy to find in the future.

In addition to their assistance with the tournaments, the ladies under Chairman Helen Valentine were responsible for very productive fund raising activities including two sausage sizzles and raffles. These funds were used to subsidise the State Junior teams. Also after some early hiccups the 75th Anniversary Dinner and trophy presentation will be held on 23 November.

In the absence of a Match Director for most of the year some problems were encountered mainly in relation to fixturing. However with appointment of Adrian Reeves from the start of Spring Pennant things seem to have settled down. Chris Marsh continues to fulfil the Official Scorers position with aplomb.

David Brown as Coaching Director has worn several other hats, including his heavy involvement with Athletes with Disabilities, so much so that one of his athletes is in an Australian development squad and may be a possible candidate to compete at the Rio Paralympics. In that regard congratulations are extended to Connor Johnston on his selection in the Australian team that went to Thailand. Additionally he conducted five Junior Graded Tournaments and two schools tournaments and conducted numerous active after school sessions. Also he ran a level 0 coaching accreditation course which resulted in ten new coaches. A visit by national coach Jens Lang was well coordinated by Lyn Nolan.

Long standing State Junior coach Dennis Chen was replaced by Craig Campbell and newly arrived Alvin Jiang was appointed senior coach. As a result of the enthusiasm of these two coaches participation in coaching sessions was greatly increased. Western Australian participation in the National (senior) championship was only second to the host state. Three Men's, One women's and an under 21 Women's team were entered. Bronze medals were won By Katy Valentine and Holly Nicolas in the under 21 Women's Doubles. Hollys performances led to her selection in the team to compete in the Oceania championships in New Caledonia. As Western Australia is due to host this championship in 2014 it was pleasing that we had such a strong representation.

Again Western Australia was well represented at the Junior Championship and I must compliment Verona Johnstone for her efforts in managing the teams. The under 15 girls won a bronze medal and team members Holly Nicolas and Katy Valentine were listed in the order of merit as was Pan Yi. This year the Veterans stole the thunder by winning the over 40 team's event. This is the fifth team title achieved by WA in National Championships and the second for the 40's. Team members Craig Campbell, Jeff Drew, Greg Letts and Russell Stein are to be congratulated on their efforts.

Webmaster Otti Beerli saw through with the help of Namoi Jensen the setting up of the new Association website. This will always be a work in progress as additional information is posted and improvements made. Otti was also the driving force behind the development of a new constitution for the Association.

Greg Letts continued his record stint as editor of 11UP which he prepares on a professional basis. Additionally Greg assisted in the coaching of our juniors and was ever willing to provide support to the office in the computing area. Phil Ranger(Snr) continues to look after the junior club and he has guided many a junior to serious competition. Notably through the Morley club Phil has encouraged many juniors to participate in the pennant competitions.

Apart from the Board members there were, many other volunteers too numerous to name. To name a few Charles Ellwood, Paul Andriessen, Lindsay Mee and Maureen Hooper. Maureen has looked after and nurtured our gardens for years and the results speak for themselves. Charles has assisted in numerous ways, not the least of which has been his regular contribution in putting together 11Up. Lindsay has also been a tower of strength. His efforts to brighten up the appearance of the Centre and improve it have not gone unnoticed. Paul is forever maintaining the scoring machines.

I would like to thank our Canteen Manager, Peter Mascall, for his efforts in managing the Centre. Peter McKenzie continued as the centre cleaner and by cleaning well outside normal opening hours has allowed for greater utilisation of the Centre.

The excellent support received from the Department of Sport and Recreation, from Healthway has been most appreciated. However the support from the Town of Victoria Park in relation to facilities has been well less than desired. It seems that they are trying to back away from an earlier commitment to assist us with a new venue.

FINANCE DIRECTORS REPORT

The Association made a profit of \$26418 which was well up on last years profit of \$6984. The increase in profit was mainly due to the \$13868 profit on hosting the Australian Junior Championship and the \$12,477 increase in centre profit.

The marked increase in Centre profit has resulted from increased coaching activities and a flow onto general hiring. Attempts are being made to have the centre available to members for longer hours and this has resulted in an increase in income.

Core funding from the Department of Sport and Recreation (DSR) was maintained at \$16,000 and will be maintained in 2013/14. Also the DSR provided a \$10,000 grant toward the hosting of the Australian Junior Championships and additional funding of in excess of \$9,000 has been provided for country enrichment scholarships, a sport recreators project and for the development of a strategic plan.

Development funding from Healthway for the 2013 calendar year amounted at \$13,000. Additionally Heathway continued to provide \$2,500 sponsorship for the State Championship. Future funding has been tied into calendar years with \$16,000 being approved for the 2014 calendar year. Healthway income was supplemented by the ASC'S 'Active After School' program which complements the development activities of the Healthway program.

The Association net contribution toward state team travel and entry fee expense amounted to \$22,387 of which of which approximately \$4,000 was provided by the Associations fund raising committee.

Overall the Association is in a very sound financial position with current working capital (Current Assets less Current liabilities) in excess of \$76,000 and having over \$24,000 in the Centre Fund which will be needed if we secure a new venue.

NOTES TO, AND FORMING PART OF, THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS YEAR ENDED 30TH SEPTEMBER 2013

NOTE 1 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Basis of accounting

These financial statements are a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the requirements of the Constitution to prepare financial accounts. The Board of Management have determined that the Association is not a reporting entity as defined in Statement of Accounting Concepts 1: Definition of the Reporting Entity, and therefore there is no requirement to apply accounting standards in the preparation and presentation of these statements. The statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the following Accounting Standards and UIG Consensus Views:

AASB 102 - Inventories

AASB 107 - Statement of Cash Flows

AASB 108 - Accounting Policies, Changes in Accounting

Estimates and Errors

AASB 116 - Property, Plant and Equipment

AASB 1031 - Materiality

No other Accounting Standards or UIG Consensus Views have been applied.

The statements are prepared on an accruals basis from the records of the Association. They are based on historical costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following specific policies, have been applied in the preparation of these statements:

(b) Depreciation

Depreciation on buildings, plant and equipment has been provided for on a diminishing value basis, so as to write off the cost of the assets over its effective working life.

(c) Inventories

Stocks have been valued at the lower of cost or net realisable value. Cost of inventories is determined on a first in first out basis and is assigned to inventory on the basis of specific identification.

(d) Employee entitlements

Provision is made for the Association's liability for employee entitlements arising from services rendered by employees to balance date. Employee entitlements expected to be settled within one year together with entitlements arising from annual leave which will be settled after one year, have been measured at their nominal amount.

NOTE 2 - INCOME TAX AND GOODS & SERVICES TAX

The Association is exempt from income tax under the provisions of Section 50-45 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997. As the Association turnover exceeded the \$100,000 threshold at that time for non-profit bodies, the Association was required to register for GST as from 1 October 2001.

David Brown – WATTA Coaching Director.

This year has been one of the most interesting in my role as Coaching Director and the Coaching and Development plans we put into place are now starting to show some degree of success.

Our first proposal was to change the coaching regime and create two coaching appointments with Alvin Jaing as State Senior Coach and Craig Campbell as State Junior Coach. Both are experienced players in their own right, competing at State and National level.

These appointments were designed as part of a two year plan to change the way we develop players at senior and junior levels, culminating in State representation at the National Championships. The first year was always going to be experimental and a few hiccups along the way were to be expected but by and large most players were happy with the outcome and with a few changes I'm confident that the next year will be more successful.

All these changes in the coaching staff couldn't have taken place without an increase in National Coaching accreditation process and to that end I ran a TOPS coaching course (Level 0) in February for 10 participants all of which passed and now hold this level for the next 4 years.

My intention was to hold a level 1 course later in the year but work load in my Development Officers role and an ongoing health problem prevented me from this but hopefully it will happen next year.

The coaching system now in place involves State senior and junior sessions at WATTA and development sessions at Kingsway TTC run by myself and Peter Jokic running a similar session at Fremantle TTC. The development players involved in these sessions come from a variety of sources though in-school and out of school activities (AASC), talent spotting and open days and organized junior tournaments and the WATTA junior club.

I now move on to my Development Officers role which has been a busy and productive year with involvement in school and disabled activities, coaching clinics and tournament organization.

The junior graded tournaments have attracted 98 players and have been very successfully played in a number of different metropolitan areas and the junior and senior schools competitions have again increased from last year with the added problem of where to put year 7 students as some are in High school and some in Primary.

School visits to promote table tennis has been a priority this year and an increase in disabled athlete participation is ongoing with a number of new junior players becoming involved.

I would like to extend by thanks to all the coaching staff for their help and assistance throughout the year and look forward to another productive term in office.

THE WESTERN AUSTRALIAN TABLE TENNIS ASSOCIATION (INC) 2013 ANNUAL REPORT AND YEARBOOK MATCH DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Winter 2013 Pennants saw the introduction of 2 player teams for A-grade, with all A-grade single rubbers being of the best of 7 games. The aim of 2 player teams is to encourage juniors to take part in pennants and to reduce the time to complete matches, which often go past 11pm for the 3 player team matches. No complaints or negative feedback was received regarding the new A grade format, which will continue in 2014.

Note: Match committee will send out email survey for feedback on match format and suggestions.

It was encouraging to see a small increase in teams and players enter winter pennants with 26 teams & 115 players, up from 2012 with 19 teams & 97 players. However, there were few additional A grade level junior players taking part. This may be due in part to poor notification prior to the winter season. Hopefully we shall see a higher junior take up in winter 2014 pennants.

The WATTA Cup saw some very close matches that had to be double checked by teams and the match committee, which indicates the current grading system is proving to be a fairly accurate tool. Morley Swat won the 2013 WATTA Cup.

Spring 2013 Pennants

The match committee apologise for the scheduling mistakes in the first few rounds of the A Grade Spring pennants, the mistakes were corrected but unfortunately an old version of the schedule was published in error.

I would like to thank the match committee members, Lindsay Mee & Chris Marsh and would like to acknowledge Chris Marsh's great work in the background recording all the scores, updating league tables and maintaining the rankings list.

Moving forward we are looking to make pennant match data available online for easy access.

 promoted.
- VISIT BY HIGH PERFORMANCE COACH / NATIONAL HEAD COACH One of the biggest achievements of the year was in facilitating Jens Lang (High Performance Manager/ National Head Coach Table Tennis Australia) to visit WA for a three and half day visit in July. During this visit Jens had a number of coaching sessions with Junior and Senior Players and provided opportunities for WA Coaches to speak about current coaching techniques. He also met with the DSR and members of the Board. The coaching sessions were a tremendous boost to the enthusiasm and interest of all players particularly the juniors. It is anticipated that visits from the High Performance Coach will become a regular event in WA. A thank you to Greg Letts who has agreed to be the High Performance Contact Person in WA.
- INTERSTATE AND OVERSEAS EVENTS WA Table Tennis Association sent participates to a range of interstate and overseas events this year, where they achieved some excellent results. One event of particular mention is that nineteen juniors participated in the "2013 Ozcare Junior Table Tennis Championships" in Croydon Victoria in September /October. Over 30 players, coaches and family members travelled to Victoria on Football Grand Final day, thank you to the wonderful Coaches, Manager and Assistant Managers for smoothly facilitating and coordinating the attendance of so many at an interstate event. Thank you to the players representing WA with enthusiasm and politeness, and so promoting WA Table Tennis during the championship and are no doubt continuing to do so on their return to friends and school.
- WEB SITE A big thanks to Othmar Beerli and Naomi Jensen for all their work in getting the WA
 Table Tennis Association web site up and running in October 2013. The website enables new and
 current players to access information about table tennis in WA and will no doubt be the main means
 of communication in the future. Table Tennis in WA can now be promoted through the electronic
 world.
- RADIO INTETRVIEW S Thank you Greg Letts for the high quality Radio Interview that you participated in with Ryan Cope on 990AM's "Not the Footy Show", as a member of the Winning 0/40's Men's team at the 2003 Australian Veterans Championship. Irwin Parker also did an excellent job of promoting WA Table Tennis in a Radio interview just prior to the State Table Tennis Championships.

Given that we now have a functional web site, and stable staff within the WATTA office, there is huge potential for promoting Table Tennis within WA during 2014.
